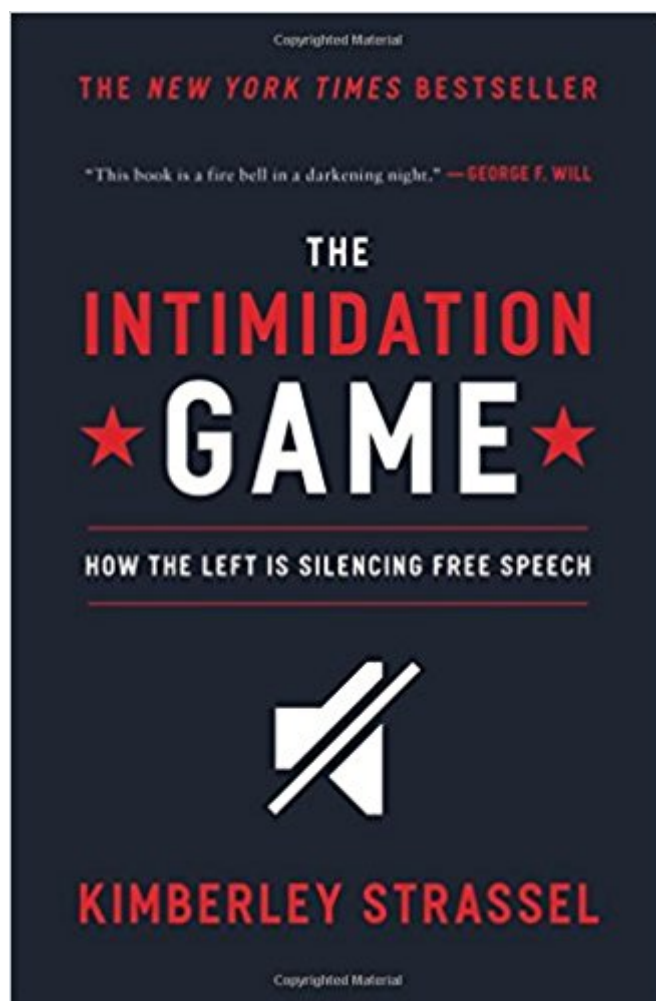


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The Intimidation Game: How The Left Is Silencing Free Speech

The abuses of federal power are plenty to spread around to all branches, departments, and parties, but the left especially seems taken to the tactics exemplified in this writing. After all, the most striking difference I see between the left and right is not that only one wishes to expand the role of the federal government, but rather, primarily one is willing to allow the ends to justify the means. I am almost ashamed of what has become of our country and am discouraged at the thought of how to influence a return to a constitutionally governed republic whose government has little more than a primary duty to protect and defend its citizen's unalienable rights. After all, look at the choice before us in the upcoming presidential election: narcissistic know-it-all man-child with an inferiority complex (we currently have one of those) and scandal ridden pathological lying elitist Clinton (previously had one of those).

Proper disclosure: I have been reading Kim Stassel's weekly column in the Wall Street Journal for at least a decade now, and the woman is a force of nature. She is the epitome of what a journalist/columnist should be. And she does it all with a natural modesty and professionalism that none have matched and many could emulate. To the book itself: Many believe that the intimidation

and suppression of political speech during the Obama years begin and end with the IRS targeting of conservative non-profits. That is but the tip of the iceberg, and this book shows the enormity of the rest of the iceberg that most people don't see. I am a Jew and I despise alarmist and misguided comparisons of different forms of oppression to Nazism.
