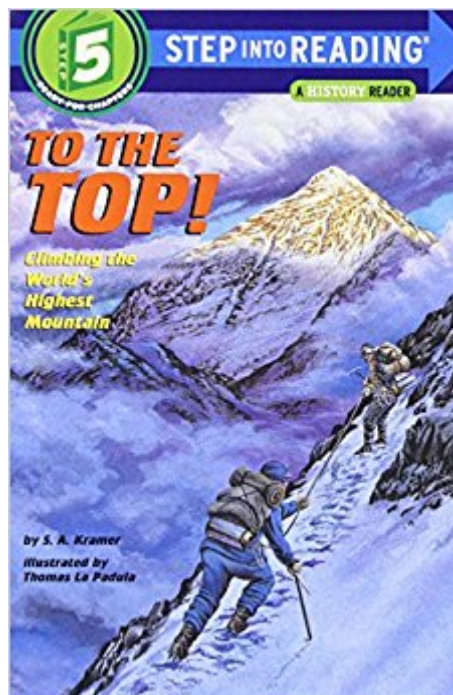




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To The Top! Climbing The World's Highest Mountain (Step-Into-Reading, Step 5)
