

Great day hikes and the pictures are wonderful - you really get a good sense of the hike before you go. I would recommend this to anyone wanting to take great day hikes in the Boulder area.

This book is lovely. Lots of great hikes around Boulder. Beautiful photos and good descriptions and history. I've discovered lots of new places I'm interesting in going to. However, the maps leave a lot to be desired. I don't expect a fold out topo map but at least something that shows connections to other trails. Sometimes the dotted line that is supposed to indicate the trail just sort of heads out into space. Often no markers to indicate landmarks, intersections, elevation gain etc. You might as well

just tell me where the trailhead is and forget the map page! Nevertheless, I do recommend it for a great listings of lovely hikes. Just buy your own map.
