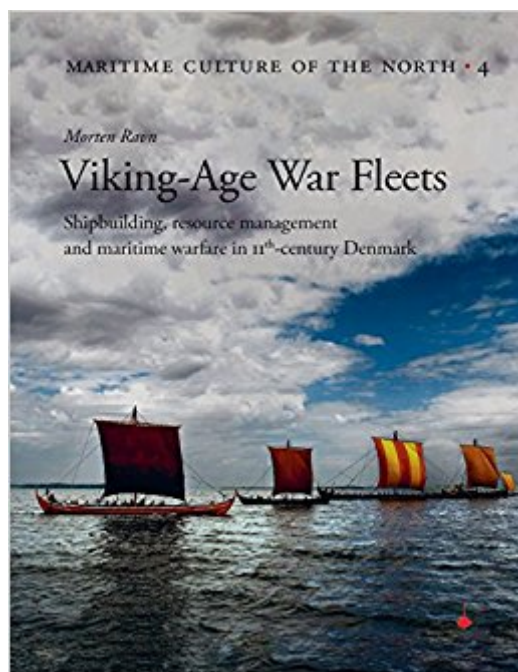




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Viking Age War Fleets: Shipbuilding, Resource Management And Maritime Warfare In 11th-century Denmark (Maritime Culture Of The North)
