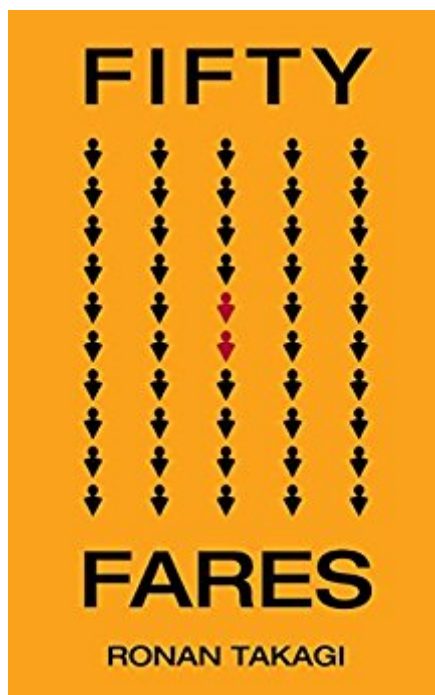

The author, stuck in a rut (like many single 30 somethings figuring their lives out), tries something completely out of the ordinary for him and begins a journey through parts of his hometown he had never seen before. Self deprecating humor, admitted elitism, and plain ole "get off my lawn" grouchiness come together in a concept that is truly refreshing. Think of it as a compilation of short stories of the different types of people you'll find in LA, intertwined with social commentary. Ronan's self reflection is also an added bonus, as he discovers more and more about himself through these stories, lending credence to the theory that it takes a lifetime to know yourself. Highly recommended.
