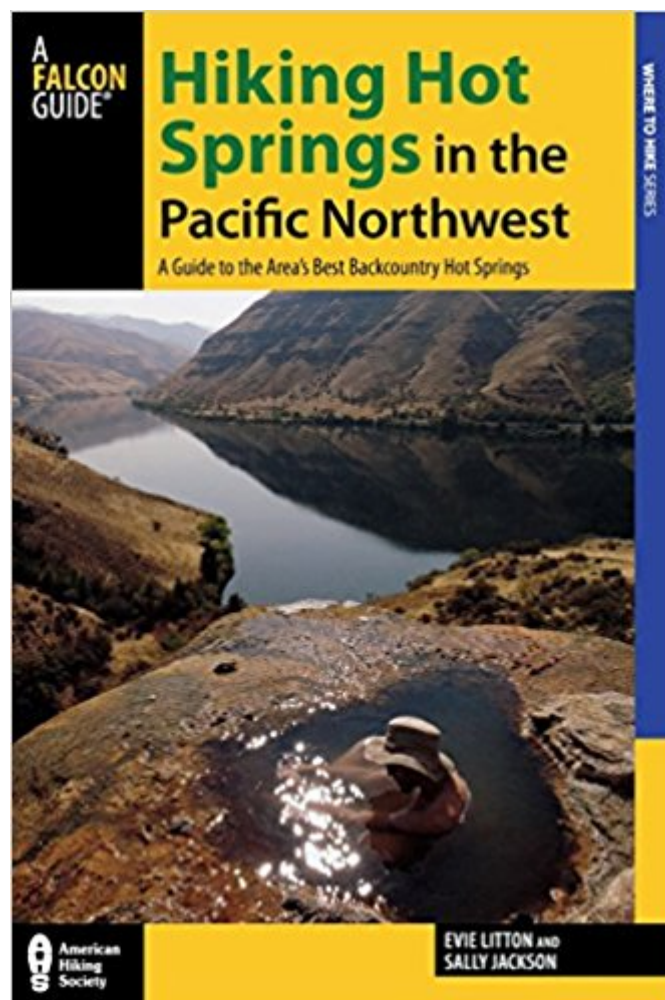

She is currently working on the 4th edition of her book "Hot Springs of New Zealand."

If you live in Idaho, this is a fantastic resource. In fact, Idaho comprises a great majority of the material in here.

First of all we love our new book! To have such a resource is wonderful! Some things that I love are the directions (though the maps could be better), the pictures of the hot springs and the overall information. One thing I saw that people were complaining about was how much of the book is of Idaho hot springs...well, that's where they are. Nothing you can do about that. One thing I had to do to help me better navigate the book was using tabs to locate the states and subsections. Also, the

Idaho map is vague and some of the towns are little ones I don't know and were not marked. I ended up finding each town and marking it on the maps so it was easier for me to know which areas each subsection was talking about. I would suggest this to anyone who wants to hike to public hot springs!
