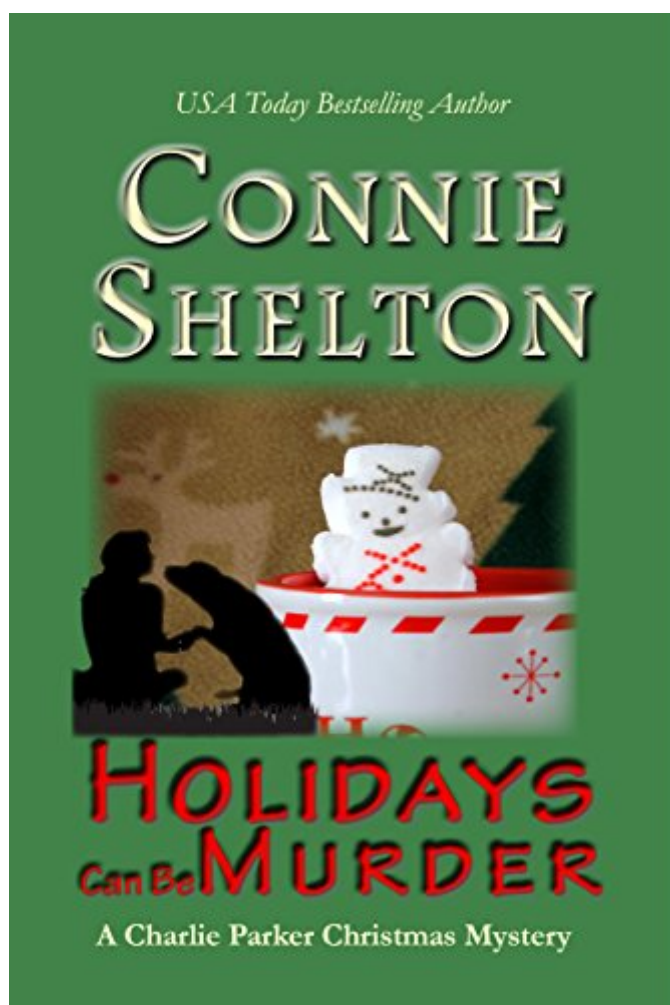

Entertaining her would be just one more thing to add to her holiday activities. Then came the call from her newest neighbor Judy, asking for help with the list of decoration required by the community every year. Coming from Chicago she wasn't even sure what luminarias were. Yet another addition to the do-do-list. And on top of this, she still had to keep up with the private investigation agency she and her brother Ron owned. Christmas came and went but the day after brought the celebrations to a stop when a neighbor was found murdered. The police have their suspect but Charlie knows deep down that they are wrong and it's her job to prove it. And prove it she does. This book is a quick, easy read that takes you on a few curvy roads along the way. It kept me turning pages while giving me very little clues as to who the murderer would turn out to be. It also has me wanting read more of this author's work.
