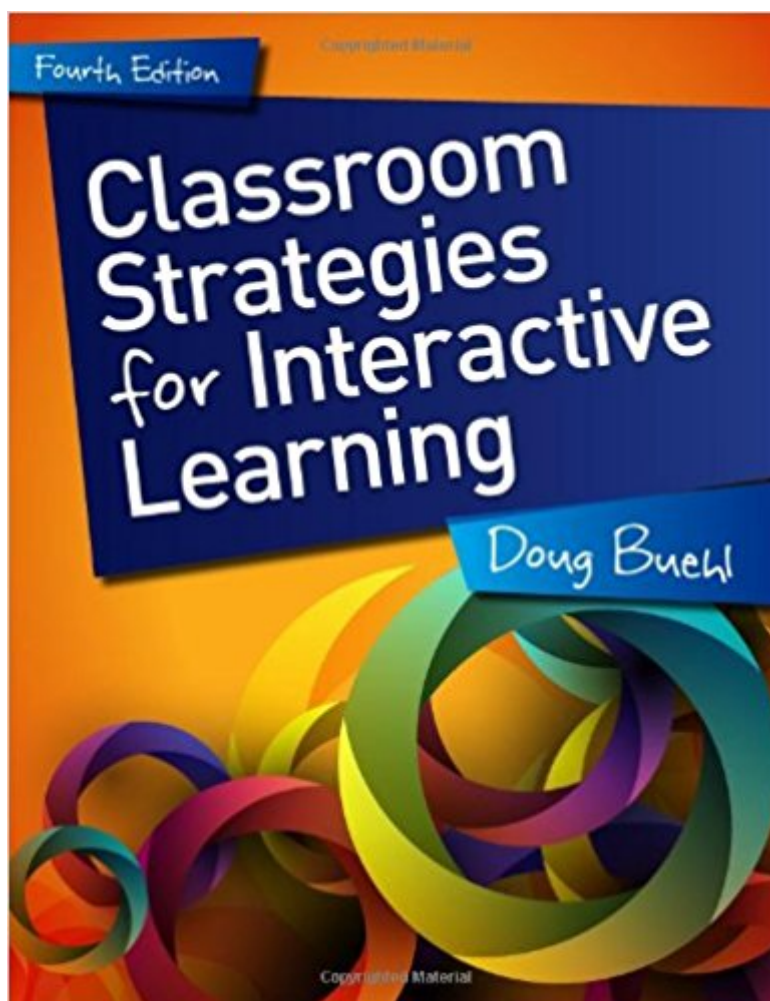

Most experience teachers who are keeping up with blogs and other news with curriculum do not need to purchase this. There are some awesome ideas, I just found a lot of them I had seen before.

A lot of the strategies in this book were useful after I tweaked them a bit (which is what Buehl recommends in another book he wrote). The book is broken down by section, what strategies a teacher might need when front loading, establishing concepts, etc. This was massively helpful so I didn't have to read all the strategies in this book to find the ones that might help me teach. I purchased this book for my Master's in Teaching program, but I recommend this book to any teacher needing an idea boost on lessons.
