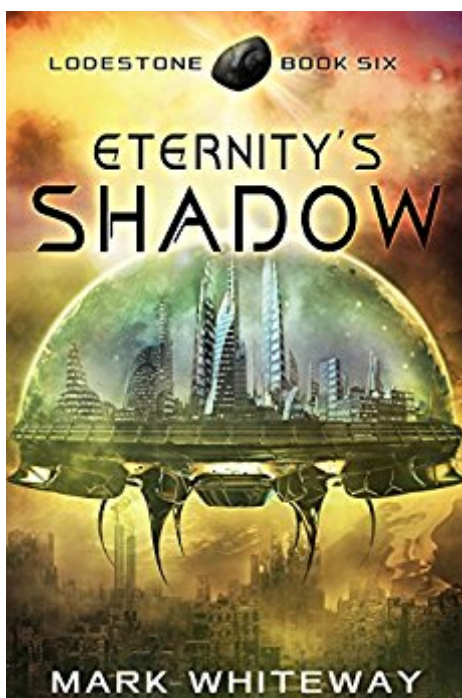


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Eternity's Shadow Sci-Fi Adventure (Lodestone Book 6)

The Lodestone Series is the best indie sci-fi show that I have ever read! It combines all of the elements that I look for in science fiction: strong plot with surprises thrown in, strong characters, intriguing mythology, and overall story development. What happens after the good guys save the world? Mark Whiteway's Eternity's Shadow answers that question for Keris, McCann, Boxx, and others, but not in the way which I thought it would. Instead, Eternity's Shadow continues the story line delving into the civilization of an alien world's past while also following Keris's quest to save the world (yet again). The trick is whether the book can pull off these simultaneous story lines without becoming redundant. Surprisingly, it does. There is a different feel with this book. It feels more evolved. The characters are the same and the situation is slightly the same, but they are more comfortable in the environment and able to express more of themselves. Keris is still as warlike as ever, but she is more reflective. She finds a great partner in Juca. Boxx is still characteristically an ally to Keris's group, but she is now has an established place with the Chandara. Other characters like Zemira and Ash return, but their allegiances are criss-crossed with the passage of time. It was a great read, especially if you want to get lost in a world of aliens and starship battles on an alien planet where things aren't quite what they seem. Mark Whiteway is the best in indie sci-fi!

I've had the pleasure of following Mr. Whiteway's extraordinary journey through the cosmos in his Lodestone Series. With the arrival of the sixth book in the series, Eternity's Shadow, comes another chapter in this amazing journey. In this novel, readers are brought to new planets, discover new plot twists, and get to see old characters brought

back to the storyline. We get to follow Keris in the present now (as the last one was about her discovering her peoples past) and get to see how much of a strong character she has become. As Keris starts investigating in this novel, we get introduced to various new species across the cosmos that can only be invented by the brilliant mind of Mr. Whiteway. With the majority of them being non-human, I expected to not being able to connect with them on any emotional level, but that was not the case here. I also love that when Mr. Whiteway introduces a new species, we aren't flooded with the details on the particular race. You kind of learn as you go and get snippets along the way. The action/fight scenes were amazing and were not overdone with gore or useless dialogue. I'm not sure if this is the last in the series but I really hope that is not the case! I had a few tears after the last chapter but I won't spoil it for others. Just read the book and be prepared for an amazing finish with some tissues nearby!

Keris is in the forest with the human McCann on a mission to find the ancient one Zemira. McCann is not one she wants to be with but he is the only one who like herself knows of the ancient spheres. When a high pitched shriek fills the air Keris does her job to go investigate where she finds one of the calm, peace-loving Chandara dead. Just as she is about to find out why, others arrive to lead her and McCann to the Great Tree of the Chandara where she is accused of murder. Only the link can save her and produce the truth but what will happen to her will she become lost like Zemira? With no other choice there is only one thing to do. As a follower of this awesome series I couldn't wait for the next book as each one just gets better and better. I love Whiteway's writing style that is like no other. The imaginative writing is so crisp, detailed, fast-moving and captivating allowing my mind's eye to play out each scene as a moving picture. His stories are more than sci-fi and more than adventure mixed with fantasy allowing an escape that one never wants to leave.
