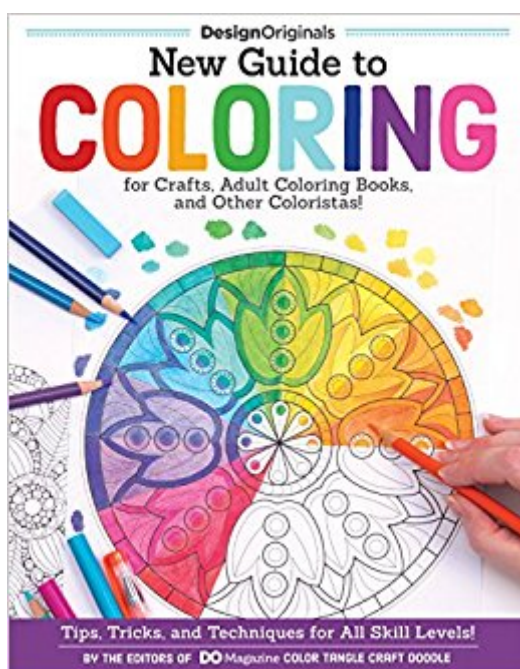

Every design arrives fresh from the artist’s studio. And the designs bring with them the soul, the influence, and the story of that artist. That is what makes this magazine so special more than just coloring, we take coloring off the page and into the home. Printed on archival-grade, acid-free, 200-year paper, our coloring pages are perforated and detach easily for gifting or display.

I took collage level art classes over 20 years ago and am a bit um rusty since I mostly do collage. But I was itching to get out of the trial and error phase with my colored pencil and markers. After reading reviews here and elsewhere I decided to take the risk. Since everyone’s levels differ and everyone learns differently I was worried. Fortunately I am more than happy with this book. The

samples are so clear, no photos with someone's hands that are too far away. These show detail as well as a comfortable distance out depending on the technique. I love the little practice areas provided for each exercise. I also love that they took extra effort to leave plenty of room for these DIY efforts. While not always true most of the sections build on the last one, or some combination. And there was focus on layering markers, pencils, and gel pens together in a variety of ways. Blending is covered using different tools in clearly shown examples. I'm not much for zentangle patterning but that's there with information of not only how but where to make your own. This book is good for the beginner who likes brief but clear presentations and isn't intimidated by a wide variety of techniques. But I also feel it works for someone who either wants to step-up to better techniques and get a great helping hand doing that. So few art books fail to bridge this spectrum and this one surely does. Good buy. The right teen would love it. The right 50 plus who wants to do more than a single color in between the lines. I wish I had found this before the winter holidays because it would make a great gift... but there are birthdays! And remember just because you can't or don't want to do everything in a book doesn't mean you won't want to in a few month or a year. I have art books that I've grown into. You can refer to it, put it on the shelf and look at it later, or even pass it to a friend or relative. No on-line resource provides what this book does.

This is a great book if you want to learn how to take your coloring to the next step. My finished products were just okay, but now, after reading this book and applying the many easy tips and instructions, my coloring has improved greatly. I am sure that my coloring art will be worth framing in the future if I keep it up! Very informative and covers every subject there is on coloring. Easy to understand and to follow directions. It is also a bit of a coloring book in itself because it has many coloring pages for you to practice your techniques. One thing you should realize is that to color beautifully - it takes time. It now takes me 2 and sometimes 3 times longer to color something than it used to because I am applying what I learned in the book, but the final result is definitely worth it and this book is worth every penny and so is the time it takes to read it (easily in just a few short hours). I highly recommend this book to all because it has great links too for those of you that already know what you're doing. I've attached some examples of my work but I have already got better!

Wonderful how to book for coloring enthusiasts! Provides a great deal of tips, explains a number of things - such as color wheels, warm and cool colors, etc., that the average colorist probably doesn't know. Even better, once something is explained, there are exercises to practice what you have just

learned! I have learned a great deal from this book, and highly recommend it to any one who is looking to improve their coloring skills.

This is a very well organized guide for anyone new to colored pencils. It is well illustrated and fairly comprehensive in topics covered. There are drawings on many of the pages where you can practice the technique being discussed without having to flip back and forth in the book. There are 9 perforated pages in the back of the book (printed double sided) with full size drawings by various artists. There is also a convenient index at the end for quick reference to the techniques described. The paper is a very good quality. It's not equivalent to Enchanted Forest or Summer Nights but is thicker than the Creative Haven type books--not knocking Creative Haven books as I have several that I enjoy working in--just explaining about the paper in this book. The experienced colorist will probably not find very many new ideas or techniques to try, but I wish I had something like this when I bought my first coloring book--can we say totally clueless? I highly recommend this book to anyone who is beginning their journey into the highly addicting coloring book hobby, or to anyone wanting to try expand their repertoire of techniques.

If you are just beginning in coloring, this is a **MUST HAVE**. If you have quite a bit of experience, this book is a great reference. I must say that the previous reviewer was so disappointed over lack of content. I must disagree with her on that point. Considerable time is given to blending, shading, various media. I have a rather larger collection of books, and there is not a single book that covers all of the topics that she listed. Might I suggest that if you want to learn how to color water droplets, for example, there are numerous wonderful videos on Utube. I belong to a fantastic Facebook group that is about gray scale coloring and they publish loads of videos on these topics. I keep telling them that a book would be nice, but in the mean time, taking advantage of the videos! Now that I am back on topic, this book is a wonderful look at coloring over all. It tells about the numerous types of media that are available and all of their plus's and minus's. (Forgive my terrible spelling).
