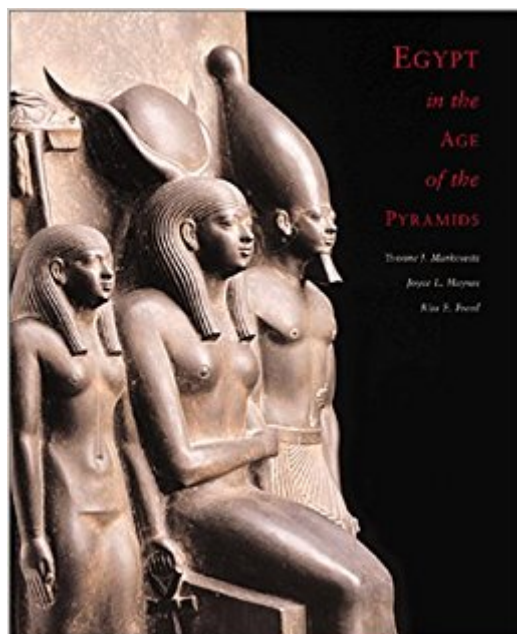




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Egypt In The Age Of The Pyramids: Highlights From The Harvard University Museum Of Fine Arts, Boston, Expedition
