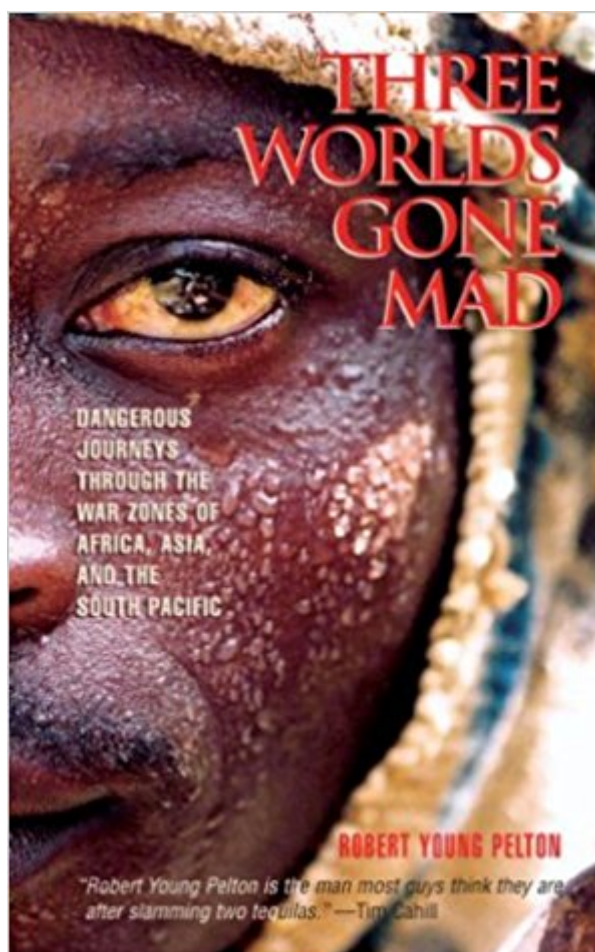

Since International Studies is my field, I find Pelton's firsthand experiences and the way he writes about them: candid, interesting, and useful. But on this publication I think that the author,

If you do not have the previous book then, "No problem," but a better book would be any edition of *The World's Most Dangerous Places* (same author.)
