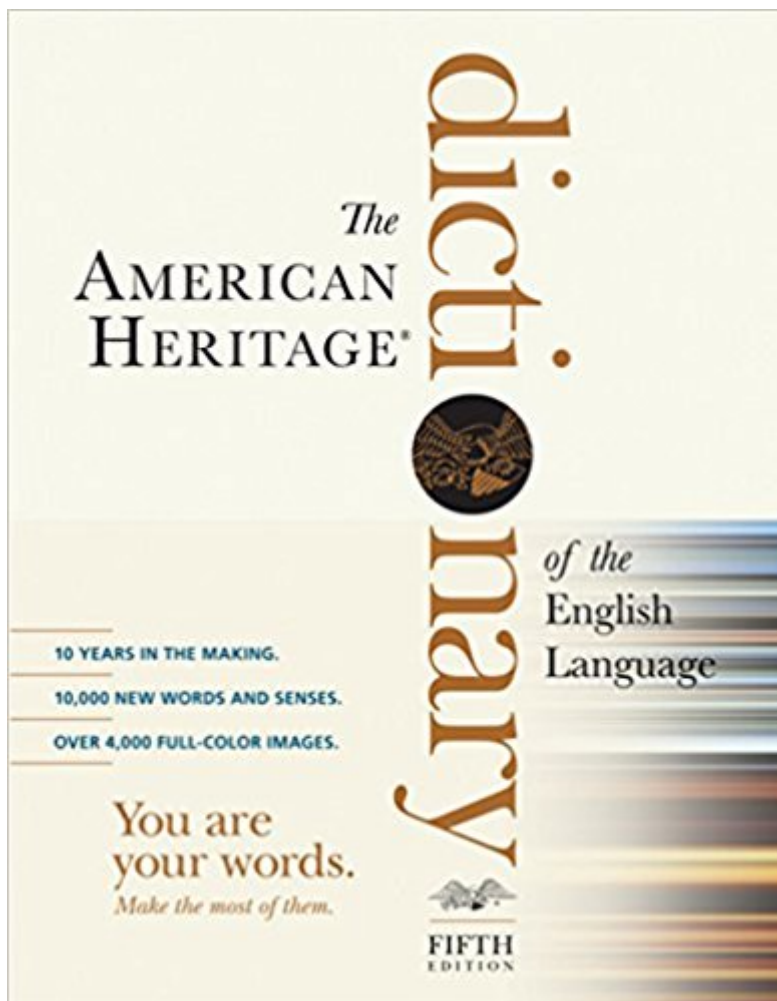




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The American Heritage Desk Dictionary, Fifth Edition

Hundreds of photographs and drawings enhance the text, and several tables such as the periodic table of the elements and a table of units of measurement provide helpful data in a useful visual format. Forming the heart of the dictionary, however, are its more than 70,000 entry words, whose clear, straightforward definitionsâsupplemented by pronunciations, inflections of irregular verbs and plural nouns, and selected etymologiesâmake the American Heritage ® Desk Dictionary an essential reference for the office, school, or home.

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I've been very satisfied with other versions of the American Heritage Dictionary, but this one has some shortcomings. For example, on p. 278, the entry for "eloquent" reads as follows: "Capable of

or characterized by eloquence: an eloquent speaker; an eloquent sermon." Yet there is no entry for "eloquence." So if you didn't know the meaning of "eloquent" when you opened the dictionary, you're still not going to know!

I'm looking for a particular American Heritage Dictionary. I've owned it before, lost it and am currently looking to replace it. Let me describe something about said dictionary in hopes that you might be able to help locate it for me. In said dictionary, if you were to look up the word "blatant" or "fragrant" you would either be given a "usage note" or be directed to the other word's "usage note". There the "usage note" would describe the difference twixt the two words. I found this to be very useful. And I'm not talking only about "blatant" and "fragrant".
