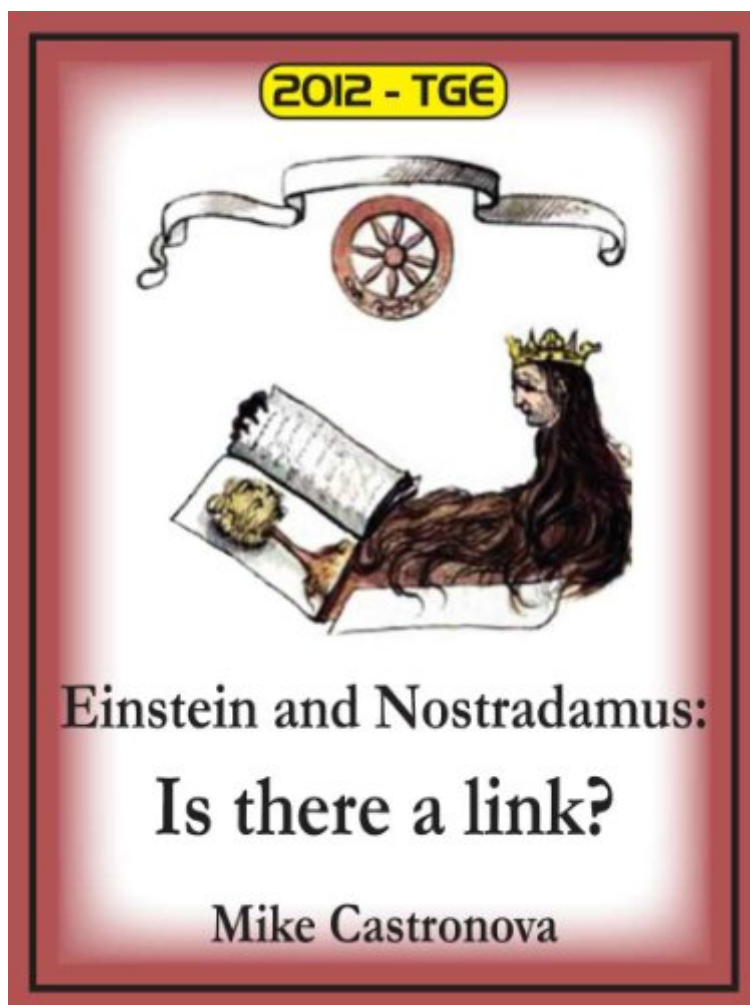

Later, when Hubble's expansion data was confirmed, Einstein decided that the necessity for countering the force of gravity had dissipated. This was his reason for rejecting Dark Energy. Enter Nostradamus The drawing on the cover of this book is from the Lost Book of Nostradamus which was discovered at the Vatican library in 1994 - by journalists Enza Massa and Roberto Pinotti. Importantly, several mass-media documentaries have examined the Lost Book drawings and concluded that they contain cryptic references to events that are predicted to occur at the time of the Apocalypse. As you will see, several Lost Book drawings depict scenes that are taken directly from the Book of Revelation.
