In an effort to bring everyone closer, her dad and stepmom opt to book a family honeymoon on a luxury yacht. A terrible storm, loss of the skipper, and subsequent landing on an island that initially appears inviting but quickly proves otherworldly and dangerous, cause the warring kids to reluctantly work together. These very human protagonists respond in believable ways to their new family situation
