

This book is a beautiful overview of the three parks and definitely allows you to start planning an itinerary. I'm a visual person and this book allowed me to identify must-sees for my trip and get an idea of the layout of the parks. My only issue is that it lacks details. Most guidebooks are the opposite (heavy on text and details with little pictures) so this is a perfect compliment for another guidebook. If you are planning a trip, I recommend starting here to get an idea of where you want to go, and then getting another guidebook to work out the details, especially if you want to plan hikes. There are no trail maps or trail details.

Prior to our visit I purchased this, Road to Yosemite, and the National Geographic publication. Since I am spending the time and money, from Ohio, I want to make sure we visit the areas I have seen over the years. I am a photographer so right off the bat, the Ansel Adams black and white prints that I have seen over the years have drawn us to the park. This book gives you where to stay and eat, the sights, best day hikes and photographs of most of the sights, info on times of the year and sections on Sequoia and Kings Canyon National Parks. Pick it up before you go.

This book had great trip ideas and information on Yosemite. We recently took a trip to Yosemite and after reading this book I ordered 2 more to be sent to my family members who would accompany us. Best over all book with great info on Kings Canyon as well.
