

There were several tips I picked up even after several months of working with a virtual assistant. The format of this book is super simple to read with bullet points and headings. And examples! Every section has an example of someone putting the strategies into practice. Even without a virtual team on a full time or regular basis this book will help you hire and manage for one off projects, and even improve your own productivity. The biggest surprise in the book was the final section about content creation. Not too concerned about giving yourself more free time? Then you should still hire a virtual staff so that you can have more time to create content and continue to grow. Your impact and meaning as a business should never be limited by what you alone can do. Bottom line? Go buy this book! It will change your life.

I waited a little while to get this book since I don't normally pay much for eBooks. But I saw it on special and grabbed it. I have absolutely no idea why this book would have anything less than 4 star reviews. The information is helpful and concise. The links to Chris's own site are worksheets or templates that you can use for your own hiring efforts. This book is certainly not an infomercial for Chris Ducker's Virtual Staff Finder service - indeed I'm going to use the tips to get better results hiring VA's than I have had in the past - and I won't be using the VSF service. I'm so thrilled to get my hands on this information all in one place. The great reviews for this book are because it is a great book. If you haven't had the success you're seeking when hiring VA's buy this book and implement the helpful information straight away.

I had heard of Chris and heard him interviewed previously before buying the book. I've found the book very useful, both in the practical component of what a VA can do (and considerations of getting a VA per project vs full time team member), and also with the thinking component, to design your business (or life) how you want it to be run. I think this book picks up where the 4 Hour Work Week by Tim Ferris leaves off - more practical examples of working with VAs. Love most of all that Chris encourages you to be kind to virtual assistants, which I 100% endorse - treating staff kindly means that they often will work harder for you and have less fear. Every time one of my VAs or contractors makes a mistake, almost 100% of the time it has been due to my lack of training and instruction, rather than the persons lack of hard work.

This is one of those rare books that I enjoyed so much, I now own it in three different versions. I started out listening to the Audible version over the long Christmas drive to the in-laws. Right from the start, the book quickly grabbed my attention and I was impressed with the very usable information right out of the blocks. For the next six-hours, it held my attention, while all the time finding myself realizing there's too much great info in here. I need the Kindle version. So later that day I ordered it. Rare is the book that has me ordering even the physical version these days. But this book was one of those exceptions. I knew this would be a resource I'd want to have close at hand, to mark up and dog-ear, to write in the margins. So now I have them all, with no regrets. Chris's book provides all the information anyone needs to take the leap into the world of hiring a virtual assistant. He anticipates all the questions and provides really practical tools to help you hire with confidence, even for non-virtual help! Buy this book. You won't regret it!

The book Virtual Freedom was brought to my attention at the perfect time in my entrepreneurial journey. As my business grows, I am finding myself overwhelmed more and more by the details of running my business and trying to keep my personal life running smoothly at the same time. Toward the end of the book, there is a section about Content as it pertains to today's on-line presence which every business has to have. Chris explained how working with a virtual assistant can make a daunting task easy when utilizing your time and theirs efficiently. That was a nice bonus I wasn't expecting. I highly recommend Virtual Freedom for anyone who ever feels overwhelmed in their business. Since reading, I've quickly outsourced my first projects and see myself continuing to do so. I'm working towards my own full-time VA in the near future and this book will be my "how to" guide to getting there.
