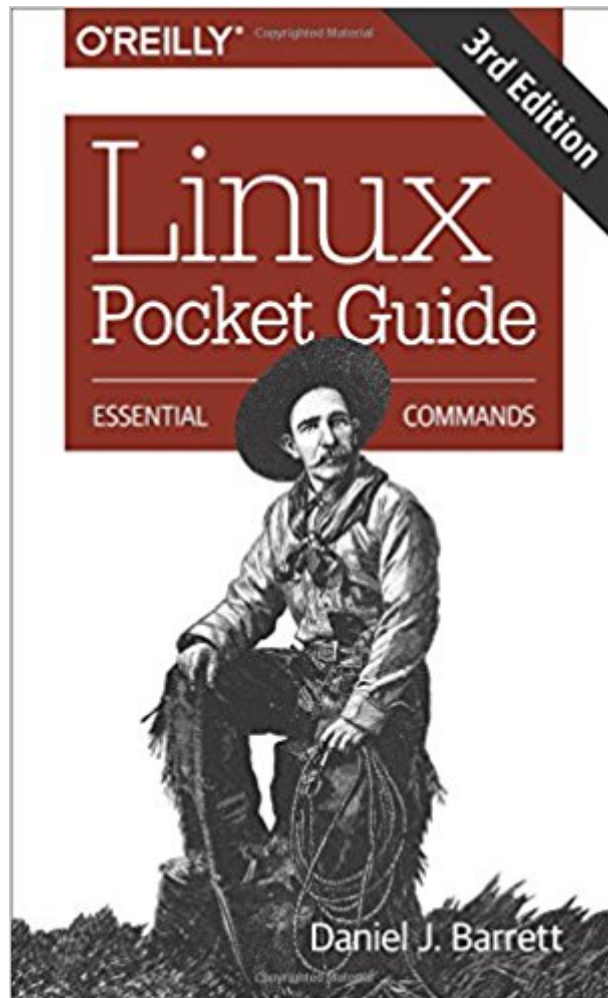




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Linux Pocket Guide: Essential Commands

This is a concise guide to many console commands for the GNU/Linux operating system. While the

book doesn't show all available options for every utility it touches upon, it shows the ones most required as well as some extended switches. More importantly, it has examples for many utilities to aid in how to actually use the knowledge. Much of the book also assists in Macintosh administration as well and has pointers to when you should also read the MAN pages in order to get the bigger picture. Great guide.
