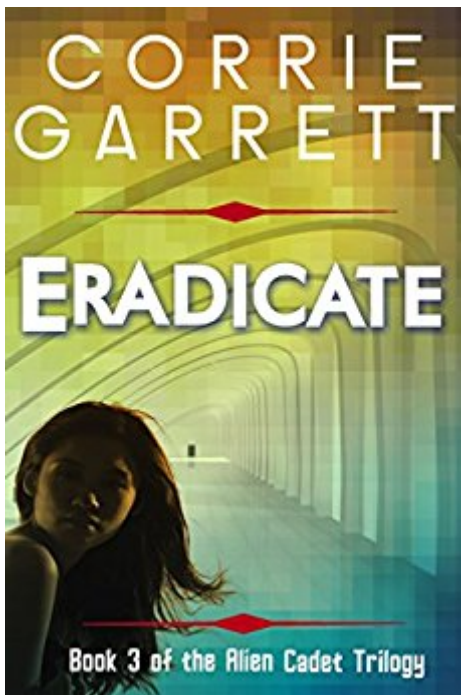

Series end after a fast pace and full of twists story. The pace slows a bit and the wrap up is satisfying but I had to stop reading every few twists to untangle my emotions. Once again I did not

expect the quality of thought delivered with the myriad of villains turning out to be something else. And the rescue! Rooting for the bad guy's reprieve and seeing no way out... Tolkien, C. S. Lewis John Bunyan, O. T / N. T. and now Corrie Garret. Well done! Come on, there's two more books left to be written. What about the Crosspoint? Aslan-like?

This is a great book and well-written with the exception of a misplaced "ejaculation" instead of? I read all three volumes as quickly as life permitted--and life has been complicated recently. I will certainly be searching out other books by this talented author. Excellent plotting and characterization, although you had to know that one of the main characters could NOT really die.

It was tense but I thought there would be more to the ending of the final book -- on the Claire's relationships with others, Akemi, Shara or maybe some MORE interactions with the characters at the end. Of what happened to them after the ending-events of the book. There was some but I felt there should have been more closure for the characters we got to know. It starts out with Faal's plan to exterminate the entire Rik race by beginning to wipe out the human-form Rik in Selta in holocaust-like death chambers as Sage had been later captured by them and his 'near-death' experiences of being marched and then watching his people get killed in different ways. Basher tries to protect Claire. Akemi is sensory-deprived by Faal as he figures out how to use her for his own evil gain while Nat and others try to figure out how to get her back safely. Read the book to find out how everything plays out!

For an initial SF trilogy, Ms. Garrett shows amazing creativity and familiarity with the whole SF genre. Not to mention she demonstrates the angst of the YA audience, along with characters portraying a certain grace and nobility in a world of revenge, insensitivity and rampant speciesism. I look forward to other works by this up and coming author!

This volume does a great job of wrapping up the story line in a satisfying and entertaining manner. I have enjoyed the entire series and was not disappointed by this final volume.
