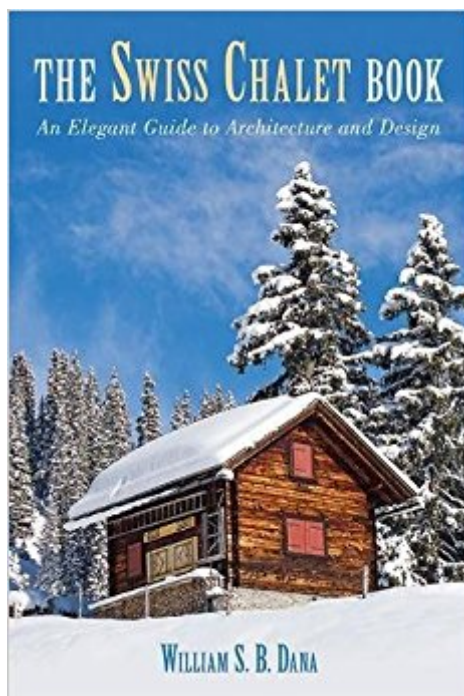

document that has been photocopied several times over and thus has lost its original detail, some are just too dark. Throughout the author makes descriptions of the chalets and its components. If we can not clearly see the details, some of the descriptions are lost. Of course, I would recommend the book regardless, it does make a good addition to any library.

The photos are fair and the text is somewhat limited. I found it useful, but not as indepth as I wanted for an upcoming design project.
