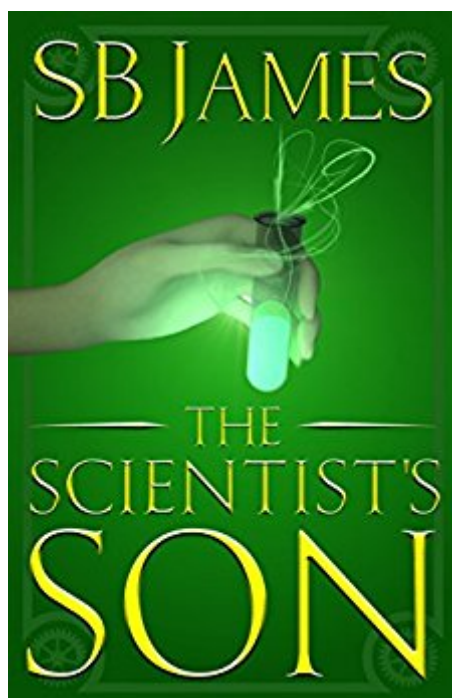

For some reason there are not a huge number of good Steampunk novels published so, if you like the genre (as I do), you tend to treasure the good ones when they come along. SB James clearly knows how to write good Steampunk stories. The Scientist's Son, book 2 in The Inventor's Son series (though it's actually the third book in this setting as the author also write a very good prequel, The Inventor's Son: The Beginning), is a perfect example of that. It's lead Ethan Stanwood is a very well-crafted character, the supporting cast of characters are also complex and well-developed, as is the well-written plot (which is actually growing in its complexity though still easy enough to follow). And, must importantly, as with its predecessor book 1 (which really should be read first), this is just fun to read. Highly recommended.
